



Canton Soccer Club House League Laws

Law 1: The Field of Play

All games will be played on a small-sided field for all age levels as mandated by MSYSA. The U5 & U6 field are 35yds x 25yds. The U7 & U8 fields are 40yds x 25yds. The coaches are on the Field of play for U5 & U6.

Law 2: The Ball

All age groups play with a size 3 ball.

Law 3: The Number of Players

U5-3v3 (No Goalkeepers)

U6-4v4 (No Goalkeepers)

U7-5v5

U8- 5v5

Substitutions are unlimited and are performed according to the GLSL rules. You may sub on:

Throw-In in your favor

Thrown-in in other team's favor if they are subbing.

Goal kick

In between quarters and half

After a Goal is scored

Injury (1 for 1)

Law 4: The Player's Equipment

All players will have shin guards, footwear, and a uniform. Players are permitted to wear a jacket or sweater underneath their uniform for warmth. If a hoodie is worn then the hood must be tucked inside of the jersey. **NO PLAYER MAY WEAR JEWELRY ON THE FIELD. THE ONLY EXCEPTION IS MEDICAL BRACELETS, WHICH MUST BE TAPED TO THE BODY.**

Law 5: The Referee

U5 WILL NOT have a referee on the field. The referee has absolute authority of the game. The Canton Soccer Club board will deal with any verbal or mental abuse of the referee. The referee has the right to postpone a game or abandon it. If you have any issue with a referee e-mail the following:

Law 6: The Assistant Referee

For all ages there are no Assistant Referees for In-House

**Law 7: The Duration of the Match**

U5- 4x5 min

U6- 4x8 min

U7&U8- 4x10 min

2 minutes between quarters and 5 minutes for half-time

Law 8: The Start and Restart of Play

All restarts will be an Indirect Free Kick. Any foul occurring inside the goal box will be brought out to the edge of the goal box at the point parallel to the goal line where the foul occurred.

Law 9: The Ball in and Out of Play

Law 11: Offside

There are no offside positions in In-House. Please refrain from having your players be stationary at the opponent's goal.

Law 12: Fouls and Misconduct

According to FIFA Laws of the Game with the addition of no sliding tackles.

Law 13: Free Kicks

All free kicks will be an Indirect Free Kick

Law 14: The Penalty Kick

Not used in In-House soccer.

Law 15: The Throw-In

U5&U6- When the ball leaves the field of play along the touchlines, the restart will be an Indirect Free Kick for the team which did not last touch the ball at the point where the ball left play.

U7&U8- According to FIFA Laws of the Game.

Please note that a player's feet being on the touchline is legal.

Law 16: The Goal Kick

According to FIFA Laws of the Game

Law 17: The Corner Kick

The corner kick is an indirect free kick and will follow the procedures outlined in FIFA Laws of the game.
